Your Career Roadmap

CMMC Certified Professional (CCP)

- Gateway to the ecosystem. Supports assessments and advises organizations on compliance
- Requires training from an Approved Training Provider (ATP) and passing the CCP exam
- Optional: Take DoD CUI Awareness Training to better understand CUI protection

CMMC Certified Assessor (CCA) – Level 2

- Eligible if you have a CCP, 3 years of cybersecurity experience, 1 year of audit/assessment experience, and a DoD Tier 3 clearance
- Required for conducting formal CMMC assessments with a C3PAO

Lead CCA – Advanced Career Track

Requires 5 years of cybersecurity + 5 years of management experience, 3 years of audit/assessment experience, and an advanced DoD 8140.3 baseline certification

Why Pursue a Career in CMMC?

- High Demand: All DoD contractors must comply, driving strong demand for skilled professionals
- Clear Certification Path: Simplified levels make it easier to specialize and advance
- Impactful Work: Help protect national security by defending critical government information
- Versatile Roles: Opportunities from technical implementation to policy, training, and auditing
- Growing Market: As CMMC rolls out, new contractors and industries will require certified experts
