Is Your Incident Response Plan Still Relevant?

Your Incident Response Plan (IRP) is only effective if it reflects your **current systems, staff, and threats**. If it's been more than 6 months since your last review—it's time for an update.

Review Your IRP Every 6 Months — At Minimum

I recommend reviewing your IRP:

- Every **6 months** on a recurring schedule
- After any **major change** (new software, vendor, or leadership)
- After a **tabletop exercise** or real incident

Pro Tip: Run a Tabletop Exercise

Simulate a breach with your team. You'll uncover gaps and improve your response—before you're under pressure.

Weekly Action Item

Schedule a 30-minute IR Plan review with your IT or security lead.

Ask: *"If we were breached today, would this plan still work?"*
